In the interim he will continue to work on the existing plants and prepare the ground in readiness.

A local resident has offered to keep an eye on the Clover Lane site by clearing weeds and general tidying. I have accepted his kind offer.

2 new barrel planters have been purchased and are in use. I have placed one at Highdown Way and planted it up with new plants. The other is in replacement of the old barrel at Langbury Lane and I have replanted the existing Cordyline in it. All related rubbish was taken to a WSCC tip.

I have also weeded the circular pea-shingle areas around the two trees in the Ocean Parade lawn.
