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### **OCEAN DRIVE / THE PANTILES**

Firstly, a 'thank you' to my committee colleague Shirley Ellerbeck for her recent article in All About Ferring relating to our new approach at this site.

The 2 pergolas have now been installed to complete the structural content of the project, and, whilst slightly delayed, I am very pleased with the result and the element of formality that they provide. Thank you also to Alex Maynard and his team for a job well done.

As previously indicated, further planting will take place around October/November, being the best time for perennials. Until then we shall continue to weed and remove errant plants as they appear.
