

GARDENS REPORT – May 26



OCEAN DRIVE / THE PANTILES

After previously digging over the main beds to take out errant bulbs etc., the main planting took place on 8th April when David and I received only favourable comments regarding the new look.

Quotes for 2 pergolas were received and approved by the committee and it is expected that these will be installed towards the end of this month.

It was noticed that the manhole cover (previously partly hidden) was potentially dangerous. I reported this to Southern Water, who have now installed a new cover.

BARBARY LANE / CLOVER LANE

The new metal edging was installed on 23rd March. Further new topsoil is now to be added.

A generous resident has donated a 4/5ft Sycamore sapling which has now been planted. Bruce and I shall consider other plants for inclusion in due course.

DOWNVIEW ROAD

I recently spent a couple of hours tidying. The tub requires more compost and 2 or 3 plants to provide a little colour.

Both are kept neat and tidy by David, with no further action required.
